



NATIONAL YOUTH ARCHERY CHAMPIONSHIPS 2010

CONDITIONS of ENTRY

(To be read in conjunction with the Entry Form)

ENTRY FORMS

All competitors must complete the Entry Form together with the Archery Australia Photographic/Media Consent Form and forward with the appropriate Entry Fees. Competitors who do not have a parent/guardian accompanying them must complete an Archery Australia Parent/Guardian consent form and either supply to their Team Manager or to the Organising Committee by or at registration.

DIVISIONS

In accordance with changing FITA Rules, effective 1st January 2010 and Chapter 7.7.2 of Archery Australia Rules, the following classes/divisions will be eligible to enter:

- ❖ Cub Class when the competition/event takes place up to and including the year of his/her 12th Birthday. Cub Class may participate in the Cub, Intermediate, Cadet or 20 and Under Class.
- ❖ Intermediate Class when the competition/event takes place in the time from the year after his/her 12th Birthday up to and including the year of his/her 14th Birthday. Intermediate Class may participate in the Intermediate, Cadet or 20 and Under Class.
- ❖ Cadet Class when the competition/event takes place in the time from the year after his/her 14th Birthday up to and including the year of his/her 17th Birthday. Cadet Class may participate in the Cadet or 20 and Under Class.
- ❖ 20 and Under Class when the competition/event takes place in the time from the year after his/her 17th Birthday up to and including the year of his/her 20th Birthday. 20 and under Class may participate in the 20 and Under Class.

VENUE

All events will be conducted at:

The Archery Centre, International Shooting Complex, Whiteman Park, Beechboro Road, Whiteman, Western Australia.

Unless there are any unforeseen circumstances which prevents this happening.

RULES

Everything, including the items listed below, will be conducted to the Archery Australia and FITA Rules as applicable at the time.

NATIONAL YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS

TARGET

A full round is to be shot each day (2 days)

FIELD

24 Targets are to be shot each day (2 days).

CLOUT

A Double Clout Round is to be shot (1 day).

Dress standards will be as per the Archery Australia Rules applicable at the time with the exception that **camouflage clothing is NOT permitted** at any of the events at this National Youth Championships.

INDIVIDUAL MATCH-PLAY

All Individual Match-play will be shot at the 2nd longest distance on a 122cm FITA Target Face

Archers' scores from the **First** day of the National Youth Target Championships will be used for ranking for Individual Match-play.

Competitors are requested to indicate on the ENTRY FORM if they want to participate in the Individual Match-play.

RECOGNISED GOVERNING BODY AGGREGATE TEAM

Recognised Governing Body Teams for the Aggregate Trophy and medals are required to be registered with the Organising Committee by the completion of the Official Practice on Saturday 3rd April, 2010.

PRACTICE

Competitors wishing to practice prior to Official Practice will need to make arrangements with one of the Perth Clubs to shoot at their club grounds.

APPEALS

A \$50 Appeal fee will apply to each appeal and is to be paid on the lodgment of the appeal. If the appeal is successful the fee will be refunded, if it is unsuccessful the fee is retained by the Organising Committee.

MEDALS

These will be awarded and presented at the venue on completion of each event. If medals have to be forwarded, any costs incurred will be at the competitor's expense, except in special circumstances approved by the Organising Committee.

RESULTS

The results will be distributed at the Wind-up Function and also be published on the Archery Australia and Archery Society of Western Australia Nationals Website.

CATERING

Lunches will be available at the venue and need to be ordered before the start of competition each day. If the lunch is not ordered by this time, there is no guarantee that there will be any food available. Order forms will be available. Snacks, drinks etc will be available during the competition.

WIND-UP FUNCTION

There will be a wind-up function on the evening of Friday 9th April.

ACCOMMODATION

It is the competitors own responsibility to arrange and pay for their accommodation and meals. Should the Organising Committee find any suitable accommodation or discounts they will be listed on the website.

TRANSPORT

Transport to and from the Championships as well as to and from accommodation to the venue is the responsibility of the competitor.

ENTRIES and PAYMENT

Entries close on Friday 26th February, 2010.

Entries withdrawn before the closing date will be refunded in full. Entries withdrawn after Friday 26th February will be refunded less 20% of the fees paid. Entries withdrawn after Friday 12th March, 2010 will not be refunded except in exceptional circumstances and at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

Total Entry Fees must accompany the entry form unless special arrangements are made with the Organising Committee. Any Overseas Entrants must pay all fees in Australian Dollars.

Payment can be by Bank cheque, Cash, Money order or Personal cheque (on 1st presentation or fees and charges the responsibility of payer). Cheques are to be made payable to **ASWA HQ Management Account**. Sorry, no credit card payments.

LATE ENTRIES

Late entries will only be accepted up to Friday 12th March 2010, by, and at the discretion of, the Organising Committee and are subject to the availability of shooting positions. A late entry fee of 50% is applicable.

No entries will be accepted after Friday 12th March, 2010.

JUDGES LEVY

The Judges Levy of \$5.00 per event has been included in the event Entry Fee. Entrants have not been charged an overall fee if only competing in one event.
